**Southern Pacific Lines**  
 Only One Coupon Required

Only one coupon is required reading "Via SOUTHERN PACIFIC LINES" from New York, New Orleans, El Paso, San Diego, Ogden, Portland, or any other junction point, to any destination on its lines, or between any two of its junction points.

The recent practice of requiring a separate coupon for The Arizona Eastern Railroad, the El Paso and South Western System, and the San Diego and Arizona Railway Company, is cancelled.

No additional coupons will be required on tickets via Southern Pacific in connection with the Pacific Electric Ry. to certain points on the Pacific Electric Ry.

Only one coupon is required between terminal or junction point on Rock Island Lines and any destination on Southern Pacific Lines (including the S. D. & A. Ry.), through Santa Rosa, New Mexico. The coupon should read "Via GOLDEN STATE ROUTE," to be followed by "Rock Island-Southern Pacific Lines," or "Southern Pacific-Rock Island lines," according to which of these railroad systems is the first to be used on an interline passenger movement.

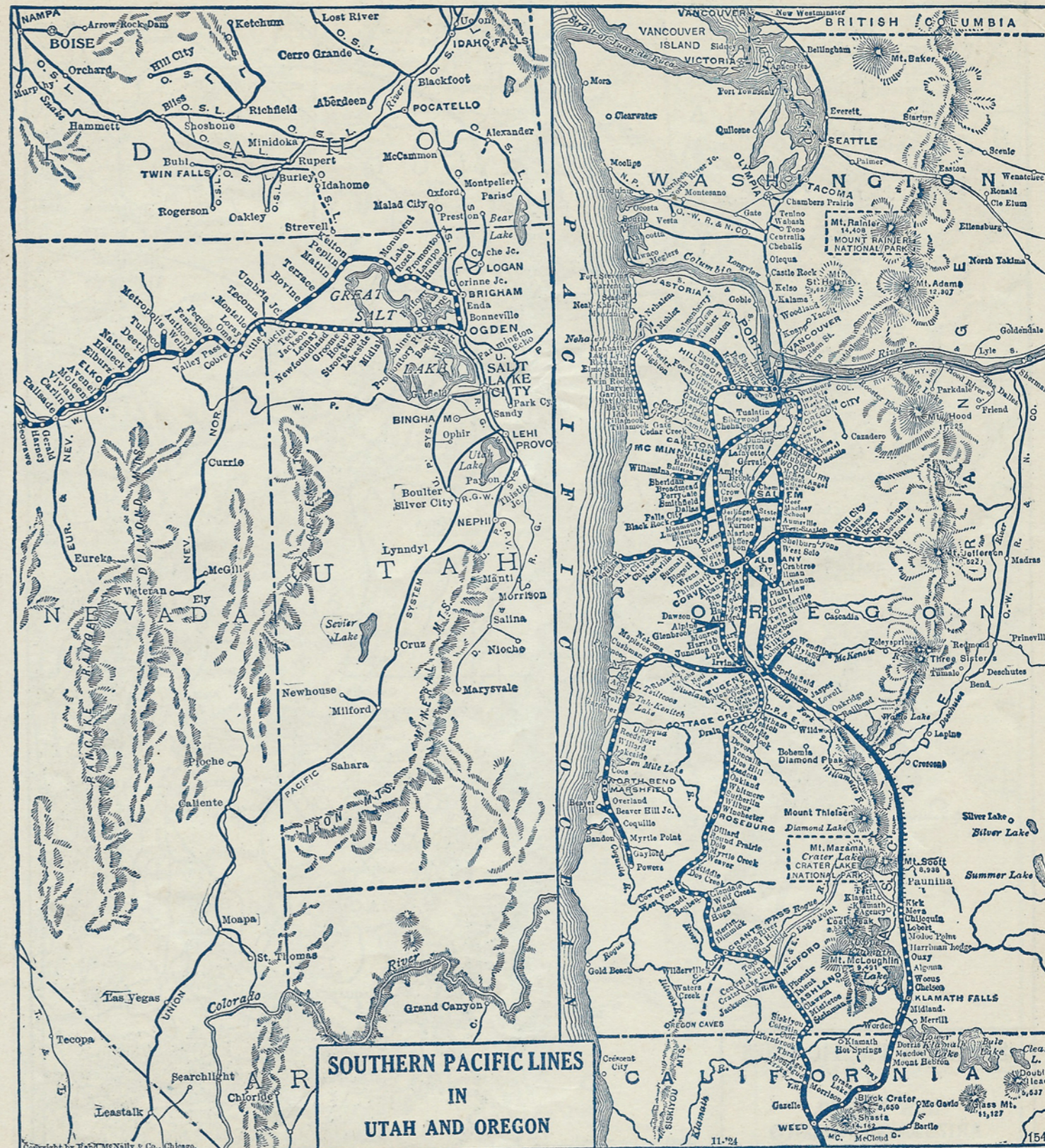

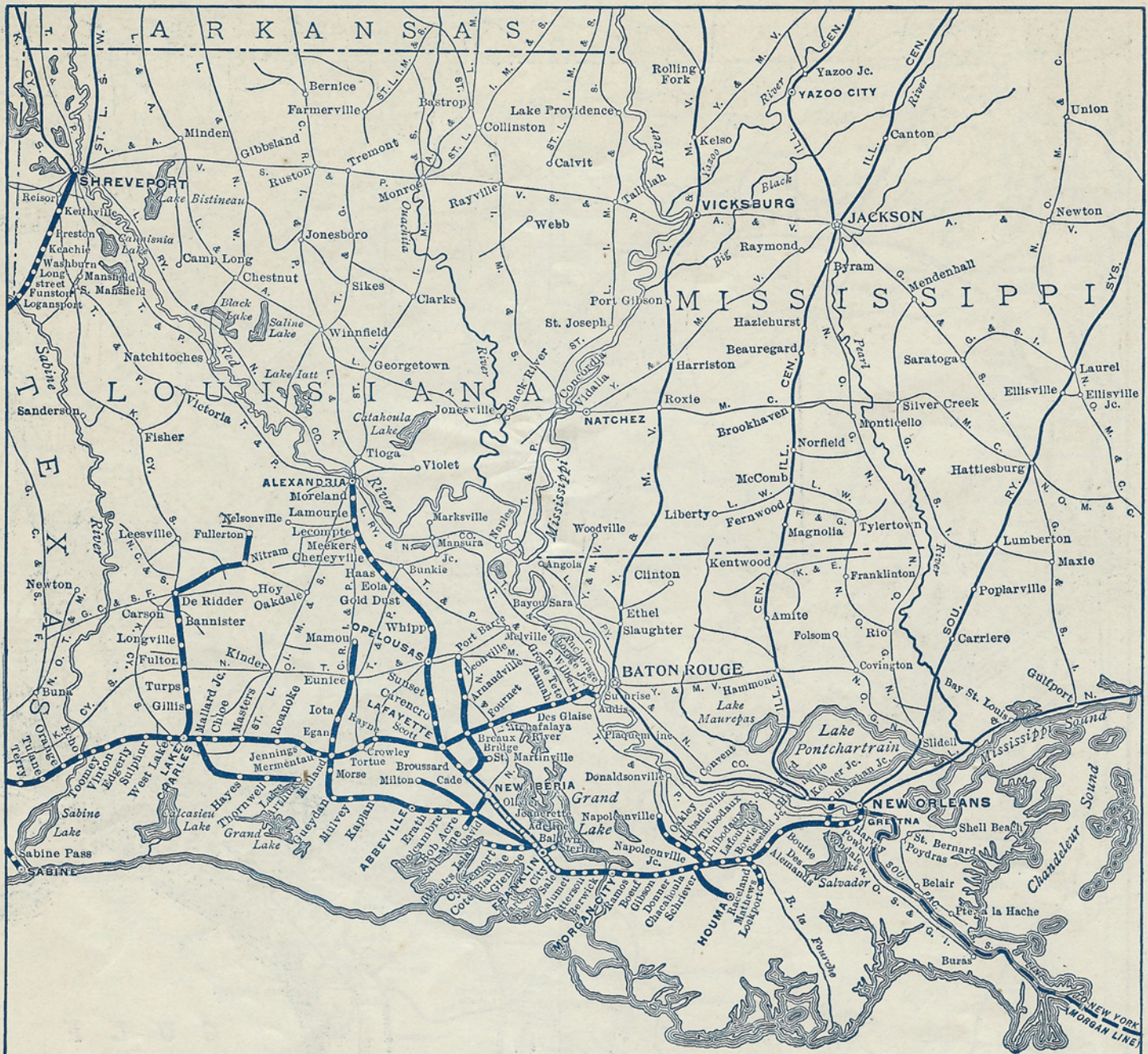


PRICES ARE MODERATE IN SOUTHERN PACIFIC DINING CARS
